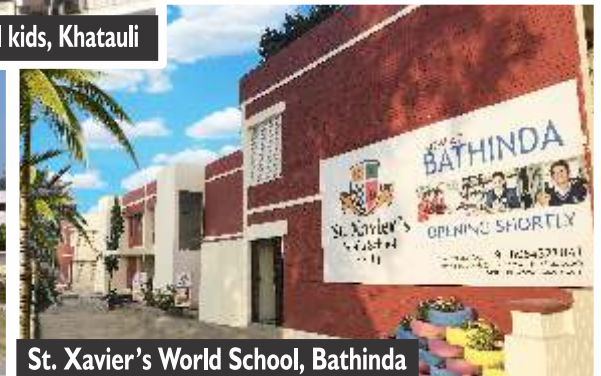

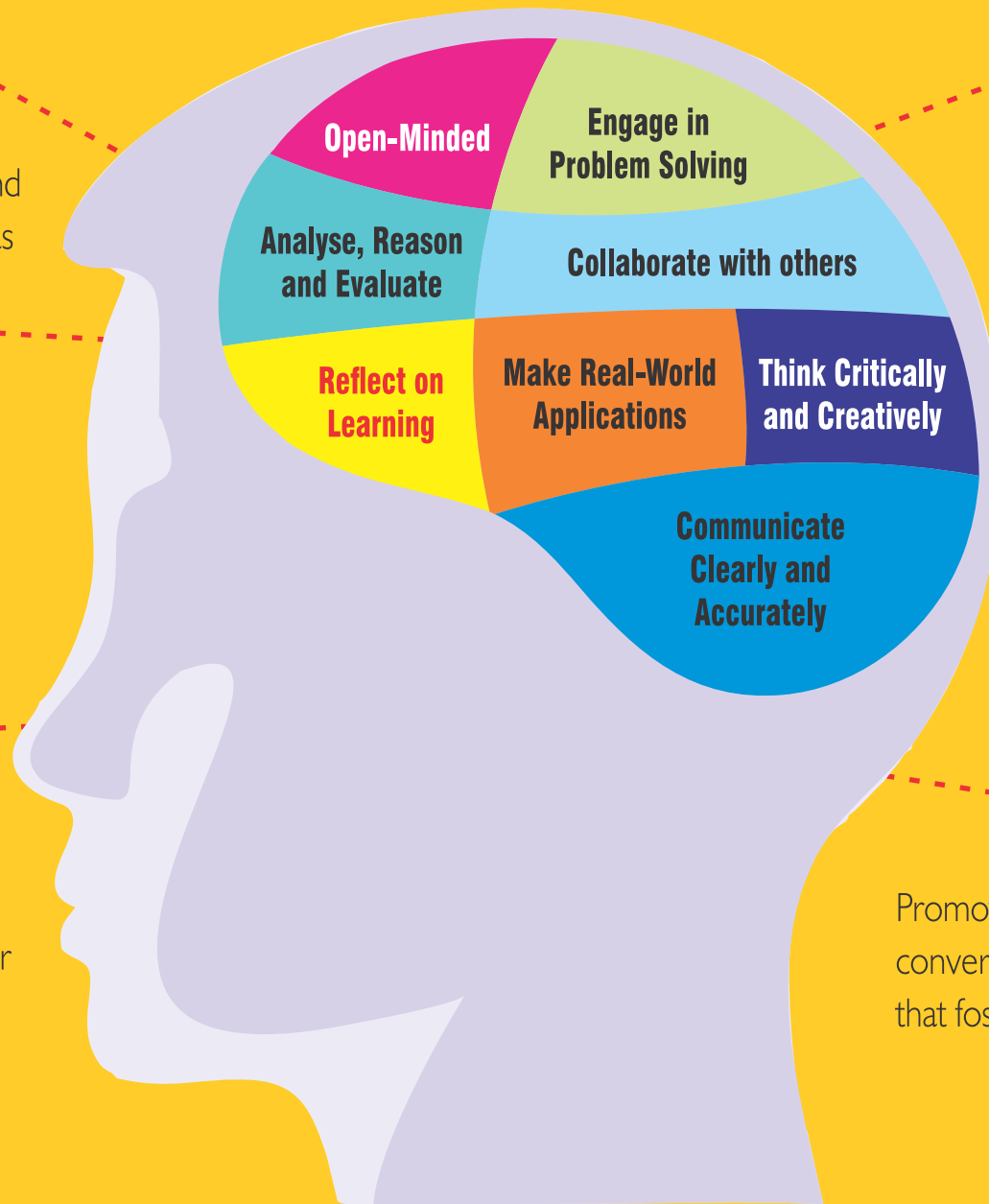

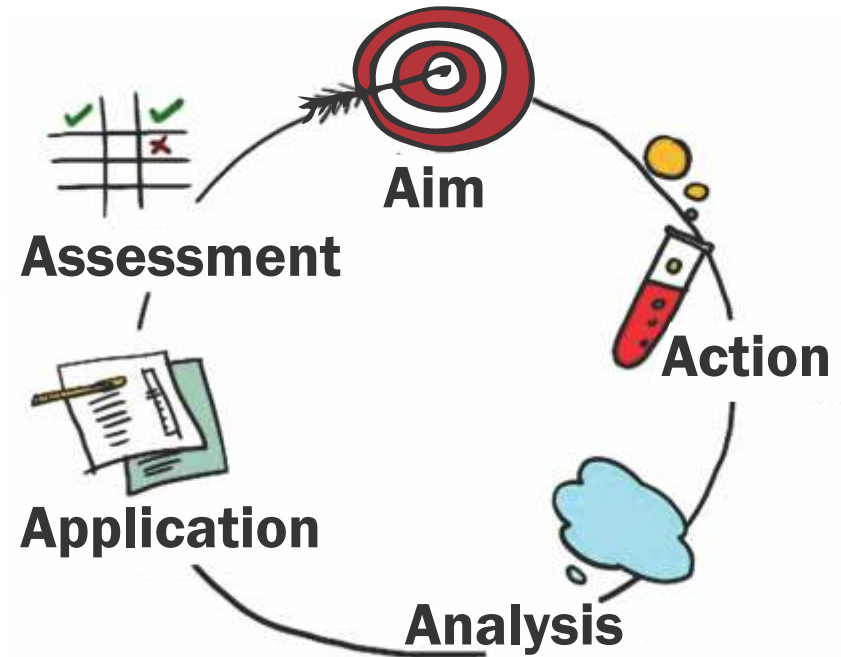

ACTION

15 Min

- Ask: What do we use to make a cricket bat, a hockey stick and erasers? Where do we get these things from? What are some other uses of plants?
- Summarise student responses. Explain: Cricket bats and hockey sticks are made of wood and erasers are made from rubber. We get these materials from plants. The tables, chairs and books we use are all made from wood that comes from plants.
- Brief: Today, we will identify some other uses of plants.
- Instruct: Observe in your classroom which things are obtained from plants. List them in your notebook. Also write the name of the plant from which it is obtained. Then add a few more things that you use in daily life that you get from plants besides food. Open your XSEED Content Book and read the other uses of plants to find out more uses of plants.
- Draw a word web on the board with "other uses of plants" in the centre.

ANALYSIS

10 Min

Part 1: Activity Discussion

- Ask: What are some things besides food that you get from plants?
- Summarise student responses. Conclude: We get wood to make doors, windows, desks and other furniture, rubber to make eraser, fibre to make clothes and paper to make books and notebooks from plants.

Part 2: Generalised Discussion

- Ask: Which plants give us timber to make furniture, doors and windows? Which plants give us cotton to make clothes? Which plants can be used to make medicines, cosmetics, dyes, for religious purposes, rubber, gum and paper? Why do people sit below big and old trees?
- Summarise student responses. Explain: Many plants like teak, sal, sheesham and Mahogany give us wood to make furniture, doors and windows. Cotton and jute plants give us fibre to make clothes, bags and mats. Plants like tulsi, neem, turmeric and mint have medicinal value. Oils or juices of some plants are added to creams, soaps and shampoos. Flowers of rose and jasmine are used to make perfumes. Some plants like

mehenufi are used for colour. Many plant parts are used for religious ceremonies like banana and marigold leaves, marigold and rose flowers. Rubber tree gives us rubber to make tyres, erasers and rubber bands. Acacia and some other plants give gum. Bamboo is used to make paper. Trees also give shade from hot sun. They also give us the oxygen we breathe.

Part 3: Higher Order Thinking

- Ask: How do plants help in getting rain?
- Summarise student responses. Explain: Plants absorb water from the ground through the roots to make food. The excess water comes out through pores on leaves. This water evaporates and becomes a part of the water cycle. Places which have more trees get more rainfall.
- Content Book (Recommended): Read Other Uses of Plants from the XSEED Content Book or any other textbook to summarise day's learning.

- Workbook: Finish S2.
- Notebook (Suggested Homework): Finish PQ4, PQ5 and PQ6 from the XSEED Content Book.
